#### 21/059 **Apologies for Absence**

No apologies required.

#### 21/060 **Declaration of Interests and Requests for Dispensation**

No interests were declared and no requests for dispensation had been received.

#### Minutes of Meeting held on 4th May 2021 21/061

The minutes of the meeting were approved by the councillors who resolved that the minutes should be signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

#### 21/062 **Public Forum**

Two residents answered councillors questions on their planning application (Item 21/063a). James Finch outlined the main areas of SCC's approach to the Bramford to Twinstead upgrade to the power lines:

- Grossly underestimated socio-economic value of the landscape
- Footfall due to covid estimated to persist beyond this year, tourism and staycation to increase
- Visible impact of sealing-end compounds
- The AONB, Stour Valley and area in between should be undergrounded / The whole scheme should be undergrounded
- The impact to the landscape of swapping the smaller power line for the larger one
- The visual impact of further pylons may prevent the special landscape area in the Stour Valley becoming an extension to the AONB
- The cumulative impact of the Norwich to Rayleigh plans upon the Bramford to Twinstead line should be defined at the consultation stage.

#### 21/063 **Planning**

- a. The councillors reviewed Planning Application DC/21/01313 Peacock Hall, Kedington Hill -Change of use of land from agricultural to campsite and the construction of 4 No. glamping huts with parking and resolved by a majority to support the application subject to the following conditions being applied to any permission:
  - The proposed one-way system needs to be removed and entry via Peacock Hall
  - ii. There should be two passing places created on Green Lane.
- b. There were no further planning applications received after the agenda was posted.

## Bramford to Twinstead EIA Scoping

The councillors reviewed the draft prepared for LCPC's response (Appendix A) to the EIA Scoping consultation and subject to any changes proposed by councillors by the 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2021, they resolved that it be sent to the Planning Inspectorate.

#### 21/065 **Questions to the Chair**

Cllr Hammond raised his concern over issues that had occurred at the Village Hall car park over the past couple of months with a letting. The Village Hall members present updated councillors on the status of the financial position of the Village Hall and the projects to re-roof the hall, install new windows and to purchase additional land adjoining its boundary. The councillors agreed to consider a donation request from the Village Hall at the July meeting.
