21/067 Apologies for Absence

21/068 Declaration of Interests and Requests for Dispensation

No interests were declared and no requests for dispensation had been received.

21/069 Minutes of Meeting held on 1st June 2021

The minutes of the meeting were approved by the councillors who resolved that the minutes should be signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

21/070 Public Forum

Lee Parker updated councillors that he had stepped down from Babergh's cabinet, that Assington and Newton's Neighbourhood Plans were now going to referendum and the enforcement action being undertaken by Babergh on land in Chapel Lane. He will try to identify the ownership of the pillbox in Spout Lane.

21/071 Emails circulated

After the councillors reviewed the emails circulated it was agreed that Cllr Hammond will draft a response to National Grid regarding update meetings on the Bramford to Twinstead project.

21/072 Clerk's Report (Appendix A)

After the councillors reviewed the Clerk's Report there were no actions required of the Clerk.

21/073 Finance

- a. All cheques signed and due for signing as itemised in Appendix B and a payment to Autela of £30 were authorised by the councillors. The councillors also noted the income received since the last meeting and reviewed the Statement of Accounts against the budget and the bank reconciliation against the bank statements.
- b. The councillors reviewed the proposed Reserves Policy and resolved its adoption for LCPC.
- c. The councillors reviewed the cash flow projection for the Village Hall following the completion of its outstanding projects. As the Village Hall would still have a healthy financial position after the projects are completed the councillors agreed that the Earmarked Reserve of £5,500 would remain until the Village Hall's position changes.
